- Banquet and spaghetti feed expenses

## WHAT DO I NEED TO DO?

- Register for soccer before tryouts begin through the school's activity registration system, SmartSchoolK12
- Get a sports physical (good for three years)
- Pay \$85 booster fee at meeting or online
- Sign up to be a concessions volunteer (if we are allowed to have concessions)
- Sign up for coach messaging with REMIND APP
- Purchase Simley Soccer spirit wear by Friday, August 14
- Make sure we have your contact information



## HOW CAN I HELP?

- We need your help to make this a successful season!
- Complete the items listed on your checklist (that you will receive at the parent meeting).
- Come to a booster meeting.
- Volunteer to take photos at games.
- Check to see if your company participates in a Company Match Program where volunteer time can translate into money for the Simley Soccer program

- Support our sponsors.



## CONCESSIONS

- We are still waiting to see if we can sell concessions this season.
- Selling concessions is an excellent opportunity to make additional money for the boosters – we cannot do it without your help!
- Each family should sign up for at least one shift.
- A booster member will be present during each shift to assist with set-up, closing, and questions/issues.

## UNIFORM CARE

- Uniforms are school property and should only be worn for games.
- Do not wash or dry the soccer bags.
- Uniforms should not be dried in the dryer.
- Cost of a set of uniforms and bag for one player is \$150. If all items are not returned at the end of the season, players will be charged for the replacement cost.
